DCSD NUTRITION SERVICES: Universal Free Meals for 2021- 2022 School Year

Did you know that all DCSD students may receive free meals again this year?

For all schools where DCSD Nutrition Services operates, the USDA has extended Meals at no cost through June 30, 2022.

This means that one breakfast (where offered) and one lunch per day per student will continue to be provided at no cost to all students.

Students are required to take a fruit or vegetable to make a reimbursable/no cost meal at breakfast and lunch.

Ala Carte food items are available for purchase. Meals will be served in the school cafeterias to students.

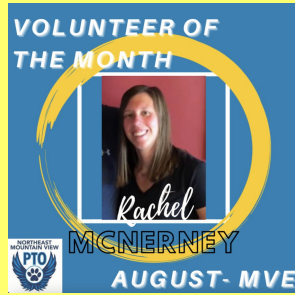


IREADY ASSESSMENT

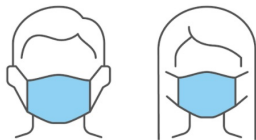

i-Ready Diagnostic

The i-Ready Diagnostic is an adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit your student's needs. Each item a student sees is individualized based on their answer to the previous question. For example, a series of correct answers will result in slightly harder questions, while a series of incorrect answers will yield slightly easier questions. The purpose of this is not to give your student a score or grade, but instead to determine how best to support your student's learning.
